Patient Navigation Within Two Federal Cancer Screening Programs

I am currently collecting data from patient navigators who support cancer screening efforts across 70 grantees of the National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program (NBCCEDP) as well as the Colorectal Cancer Control Program (CRCCP). This is the first time data has been collected from navigators themselves to describe their activities and training as well as the barriers they encounter when working with clients. This navigation experience will be discussed, contrasted to that with what program directors report to the CDC, and put in context with public health practice and policy.
